Programme update

Practice Manager's Development Programme update

The Practice Management Development Program, launched in June 2024, continues to offer valuable training opportunities:

1. Coaching and Mentoring Training (Level 5)

- Four funded places were initially offered for this course.
- Two Practice Managers successfully completed their training in July 2024.
- Two places remain available.

2. Senior Leadership Program (Level 7 CMI Course)

- Eight funded places were offered, and three Practice Managers are scheduled to begin the program in December 2024.
- The remaining five places are being directly offered to practices identified through resilient bids as needing support for their management structure. Final confirmation of these places will be made once this process is completed.

3. Leadership Program (Level 5 CMI Course)

- Seven funded places were available. Five Practice Managers have booked, with four completing the program in the final week of September 2024, and one scheduled for completion in January 2025.
- Two places remain open for interested applicants.

4. Group Coaching Session

Funding is still available for a one-off group coaching session, accommodating up to eight Practice Managers for a 3-hour facilitated discussion on topics of their choice.
