Increase Nurse Undergraduates



Plans for 2024 are to increase placements for undergraduate nurses. Currently demand hugely outstrips the availability of placements and we are keen to encourage practices and PCNs to take students and show them what primary care has to offer. There are no mandatory primary care placements for student nurses and all who get the chance to work with us have a great experience and are far more likely to choose general practice as a first destination career on registration.

We also want to promote and roll out preceptorship for all new learners and have PCN nurse facilitators ready to do this.
