***Subject:* Virtual Controller Coordination Switch (vCCS) Implementation**

PURPOSE: This bulletin provides basic information and guidance for controllers within vZDC to utilize Virtual Controller Coordination Switch (vCCS).

BACKGROUND: Previously, v-VSCS was the voice client adopted for optional use by controllers. vCCS replaces v-VSCS and simulates both VSCS (enroute) and RDVS (terminal) voice switching systems.

PROCEDURES: Controllers are *encouraged* to utilize vCCS anytime they are controlling. Teamspeak remains the official method of coordination and should be used if vCCS does not function correctly or if a controller is not using vCCS. Presence in Teamspeak remains a requirement while controlling, even if using vCCS.

A Teamspeak tag for vCCS users will be added for controllers to help indicate in Teamspeak that they are using vCCS.

All vZDC facilities will have profiles published for use within vCCS. At the time of publication of this bulletin, ZDC, PCT, RDU, ORF, BWI, DCA, and IAD are currently available for use.
